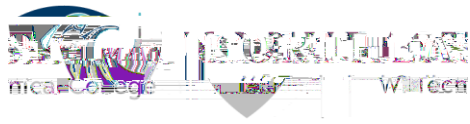

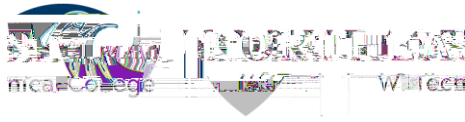

## Study Abroad Code of Conduct and Rights and Privacy Act
